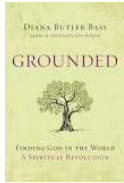

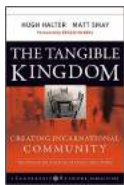

Got the call. Out of county combat Veteran got burned out. Pregnant wife. Two kids.

Saddle up. Connect him to resources.
